Do I need a power plug adapter in Honduras?

And we provide more information about the voltage and frequency. In Honduras the power plug sockets are of type A and B. The standard voltage is 110 V and the frequency is 60 Hz.

What power plugs and outlets are used in Honduras?

In Honduras, there are two types of power plugs and outlets: Type A and Type B. Both types are used in airports, hotels, restaurants, etc., but they differ in terms of shape. Type A: Type A plugs have two flat prongs on either side of the plug.

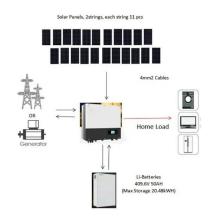
