This report provides a budgetary analysis of The Gambia government's major development projects approved by Cabinet and the National Assembly for fiscal year 2024. Each development project was awarded and approved a budget of more than 500 million Dalasis to be spent in a single year. 1. Rice Value Chain IDB: D560 Million.

How much does Geap cost in Gambia?

6. Gambia Electricity Access Project(GEAP): D556.4 Million Project Operating Costs = D290.5 million [D278.2 million in project grants, expected from France; D12.3 million in project grants, expected from the African Development Bank (ADB)]. Energy Generating Equipment = D233.9 million in project grants, expected from ADB.

Project Operating Costs = D560 million [D315 million in project grants, expected from Islamic Development Bank (IDB); D240 million in external loans, also expected from IDB; D5 million in Government Local Fund (GLF), expected from the Central Government of The Gambia]. 2. Wells, Boreholes, Water Points & Reticulation Systems = D5 million in Government Local Fund (GLF), expected from the Central Government of The Gambia. Project Operating Costs = D5 million in project grants, expected from IDA-World Bank. 4. ECOWAS Regional Electricity Access Project (ECO-REAP): D2.051 Billion.


