

Overview

What is trauma and EMS capacity building in Rwanda?

In summary, trauma and EMS system capacity building in Rwanda, based on meaningful and deliberate engagement across academic institutions, hospitals, public services, and policy makers, has been an example of horizontal capacity building.

How can we facilitate trauma and emergency systems in Rwanda?

Our collaboration to facilitate trauma and emergency systems in Rwanda was highly productive across the three central themes: creating a shared mental model, improving clinical service delivery, and investing in systems infrastructure, and therefore may be translatable to address the need for trauma and emergency systems in other contexts.

What are the technical requirements for in-building emergency radio communication enhancement systems?

The technical requirements for design, installation, commissioning, inspection, testing, and maintenance of in-building emergency radio communication enhancement systems included in the IFC, NFPA 1, and NFPA 1221 are summarized as follows: Typical system operation is continuous or automatic.

What is an emergency radio communication enhancement system?

Properly designed, installed, and maintained in-building emergency radio communication enhancement systems provide a cost-effective and reliable tool for firefighter communications during fire or other emergencies within our built environment.

How important is EMS capacity building?

The WHO and World Bank have encouraged trauma and emergency medical system (EMS) capacity building as being fundamental to health systems, and the UN's Sustainable Development Goals have specifically included cutting



road traffic deaths by half globally in the next decade as an important priority (SDG 3.6) [7, 8].

Does NFPA 1 cover emergency radio communication enhancement systems?

The NFPA 1 model Fire Code also added very similar requirements covering inbuilding emergency radio communication enhancement systems in the 2012 edition, Section 11.10 (Two-Way Radio Communication Enhancement Systems).




