

Rwanda Electricity Development Corporation Energy Storage Power Station





Overview

What is the electricity supply of Rwanda?

The electricity supply in Rwanda comes from both domestic generation and imported electricity from neighbor countries and regional shared power plants. The sources of energy used are hydropower plants, thermal power plants (Diesel and Heavy fuel generators), methane gas, and solar energy.

What is Rwanda's Energy Sector?

The energy sector, as a driver of national growth, is of priority to the Rwanda government. It comprises of three subsectors; electricity, biomass and petroleum, and focus is on increasing efficiency in generation, distribution and consumption.

Who is responsible for the development of power stations in Rwanda?

Responsibility for the development of power stations in Rwanda has been currently borne by the private sector, with active involvement from government agencies such as REG and its predecessor EWSA. In October 2014, the largest dam-type hydro-power station in Rwanda, Nyabarongo 1 (28MW), commenced commercial operation.

How much power does Rwanda have?

The country is in the midst of a rapid expansion of its electrical grid, and many new plants are proposed or under construction. Rwanda planned to expand its grid power up to 556 MW in 2024. As of December 2022, the national installed



generation capacity totaled 276.068 megawatts, with peak demand of 140.6MW.

How has off-grid technology boosted Rwanda's capacity to avail electricity to more people?

The innovation of off-grid technologies has greatly boosted Rwanda's capacity to avail electricity to more people. Rwandan households have access to electricity. of the available electric energy is imported while the rest is domestically generated.

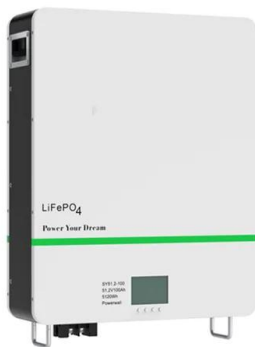

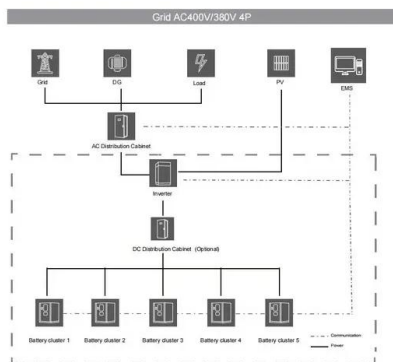

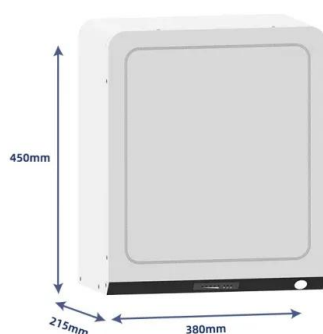
