Does Trinidad and Tobago have a satellite phone system?

Trinidad and Tobago does not have a country-specific satellite phone system. Most satellite phones operate on their country code – calls to these satellite phones follow their own call sequence. Use the same call sequence. There is no trunk prefix (1) or area code (868) used when calling within Trinidad and Tobago.

What radio station broadcasts from Trinidad and Tobago?

Red 96.7 is an urban radio station broadcasting from Trinidad and Tobago. It is directed towards younger listeners, with programming that includes entertainment, information, and music. You can listen to Red 96.7 via trinidadradiostations.net.


